ABOUT THE PROJECT


Every day around the world, countless women face pay disparity, experience social pressure to leave the workforce and are expected to perform unpaid care work. Thankfully, entrepreneurship can provide a powerful antidote to some of these labour issues that disproportionately affect women.

With that in mind, CEED Concordia and Nuestro Flow (a Montreal-born social enterprise operating in Bogota, Colombia) created a program for visible minority female entrepreneurs in Quebec and Colombia to strengthen their businesses and draw attention to the barriers both sets of women face.

The goal of this documentary project is to portray the entrepreneurial reality of women partaking in this program in Canada and Colombia during a 30 min feature documentary.

We are aiming to tell a story of union among women entrepreneurs while observing the potential racial and gender barriers that objectively surround their lives. During the filming process, we hope to learn about the entrepreneurs while they embark on their own journey of self-discovery.

The documentary will also give an insight into local businesses in both Quebec and Colombia. By taking part in this project, on top of meeting many interesting people from multicultural backgrounds, you will engage in the five main parts of filmmaking: development, pre-production, production, post-production, and distribution.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE INTERNS

- Attend workshops on cultural sensitivity
- Attend team meetings and work in a fast-paced environment
- Research, task delegation, shot list, and production calendar creation
- Coordinate shooting locations and scheduling
- Assess possible obstacles in filming and provides solutions or alternatives where necessary
- Execute shoots from a distance. Including audio, camera operation and talent directions
- Conduct interviews with relevant parties and ensures that valuable sound bites are captured
- Plans and performs video post-production tasks
- · Maintain all equipment in proper working order









REQUIREMENTS AND QUALIFICATIONS

- Creative & detail oriented
- Undergraduate university student in Canada
- Ability to work under deadline pressure
- Proficiency with editing software (Adobe Suite + FCPX)
- Must be proficient with computers and other peripheral devices, digital video cameras microphones, and video editing hardware and software
- Demonstrated experience in the areas of videotape production, as well as a thorough knowledge of audio, video and multimedia hardware and software required
- Strong interpersonal skills and ability to work effectively with staff and colleagues
- Demonstrated ability to work independently on multiple assignments and to work collaboratively within a team
- Hours required: interns will be required to work approximately 10 hours per week
